DID YOU KNOW . . .

- Here in Massachusetts, more than 800 students from more than 110 schools participated in 7 Chapter Competitions in the 2017-2018 competition/school year.
- The top 150 students advanced to the State Competition, where the top 4 were crowned as the State Team, earning the opportunity to represent our state in the National Competition.
- **At the May 2018 National Competition, our state's team ranked SIXTH out of 56 teams!**

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Liaise with the Host School, currently in North Andover
- Coordinate with competing chapter schools to answer questions/provide info on competition date and venue
- Work with the host school to provide food for dinner (Cost is covered by program)
- Order the tests through the National Website
- Order Trophies through the National Website (Cost is covered by program)
- Coordinate with volunteers to score and proctor the test
- Obtain testing supplies (scratch paper, pencils, pencil sharpeners, etc.)
- Run the competition on competition day, and help with the State Competition

GENERAL SCHEDULE, ACTIONS & TIMING:

SEPT & OCT:

Confirm dates and venue with the host school and responding to inquiries from other schools (Approx. 4 hours/month)

NOV & DEC:

Respond to inquiries, recruit volunteers, gather supplies, order tests and trophies (Approx. 4 hours/month)

JANUARY:

Prep for testing day and respond to school's questions (Approx. 8 hours)

FEBRUARY:

Run the competition on the day of the event. Northeast is typically held in the middle of the week starting around 3 or 3:30 and running to about 7 or 8 pm. File paperwork following competition (Approx. 20 hours)

MARCH:

File paperwork, and help with State competition (Approx. 8-10 hours)

BALANCE OF YEAR Until Sept Program restart:

Respond to program inquiries from schools & parents. (Approx. 1 hr/mo.)
