- Candidate must be actively enrolled or accepted into an ABET-accredited engineering program at a four-year college or university during the 2025-2026 school year (Verification required)
- Applicants must either be studying at a MA University or a resident of Massachusetts

All essay submissions shall be reviewed by the MSPE Scholarship Committee.

Application Submission Deadline: June 16, 2025 by 5:00 p.m. ET.
